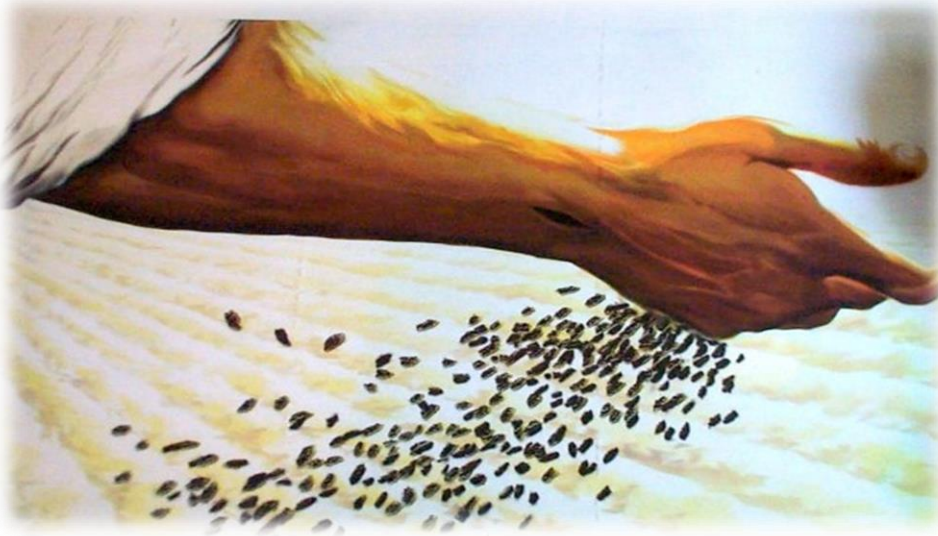

COMMUNION PRAYER:

ONE: The Lord be with you

RESPONSE: And also with you.

ONE: Lift up your hearts.

RESPONSE: We lift them up to the Lord.

ONE: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

RESPONSE: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

ONE: It is truly right and our greatest joy, to give you praise. We praise you, joining our voices with the heavenly choirs, and with the

faithful of every time and place, who forever sing to the glory of your name: And so we sing together:

**ALL: Holy, holy, holy Lord, God of power and might.
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Hosanna in the highest!
Blessed is the one who comes in the name of our God!

ONE: We remember how on the night before he died,
Jesus sat at the table with his friends,
Celebrating the Passover feast,
And he took bread, and he blessed it.
And broke it and gave it to his disciples saying:
“Take and eat, this is my body given for you.
Whenever you do this, remember me.”
After supper he took a cup of wine,
And blessed it and gave it to his disciples saying:
“Drink this, all of you: this is my blood;
The new covenant poured out for you.
Whenever you do this, remember me.”
And so we do as Jesus told us:
We share this bread and this cup,
Remembering your wonderful love for us in Christ Jesus.
Pour out your Holy Spirit on us,
And on all your people
Bless this bread and this wine
That they might refresh and renew us
As Christ’s body in the world. We pray in Jesus’ name,

ALL: Amen.

SHARING THE BREAD

ONE: Grain for this bread has come to us because other grain died in the soil to produce new life.

RESPONSE: We consider: Christ died to give us new life.

SHARING THE CUP

ONE: Juice has come to us because fruit gave up its beauty to be our sustenance.

RESPONSE: We consider: What have I given up to make someone else’s life better.

As we partake, let us praise in song.

CHANT: Eat This Bread (#527)

**Eat this bread, drink this cup,
come to me and never be hungry.
Eat this bread, drink this cup,
trust in me and you will not thirst.**

After you have taken the communion read this passage to yourself:

It is God who forgives all your guilt,
who heals every one of your ills,
who redeems your life from the grave,
who crowns you with love and compassion.
The Lord is compassion and love,
slow to anger and rich in mercy.
God does not treat us according to our sins
nor repay us according to our faults.
As a Father has compassion in his children,
the Lord has pity on those who fear him;
for God knows of what we are made,
God remembers that we are dust.
